Any third game of a three-team round robin that requires a result will go directly to penalty kicks. The team that eventually loses the game shall still be awarded one (1) point for the overtime loss. For the purpose of Goals For and Goals Against, the score at the end of the Regulation time (i.e. the tied score) will be used.
